Display results can be sorted by relevance, location, age (ascending and descending) and last time online

The user can switch between regular and gallery views, using a tabbed interface.

The number of results per page can be changed

This icon leads to the full profile instead of the detailed one

The relevance bars show how well the current result meets the search criteria. An information bubble will show up to disambiguate this feature if the user rolls over the bar.

The age, location and online activity are now displayed in one line, rather than being in different parts of the profile

Clicking '...more', the username or the profile picture opens up the profile summary in the tab.

The profile pictures are now on the right side, closer to the other important information. They are also formatted as a rectangle rather than a square.

Instead of having links for every result page, the user has four navigation options
